IAOMP CURRICULUM REFORMS WORKSHOP 2025



IAOMP Curriculum reforms workshop was held on 16 and 17 August 2025 at Kusum Devi Sunderlal Dugar Jain Dental College & Hospital focusing on declining admissions, student interest, and teaching gaps. Discussions highlighted the need to enhance lab training, clinical integration, and career scope for fresh Oral Pathologists. Comparisons were made with the 2019 workshop outcomes and 2022 DCI recommendations in light of present trends, with importance given to Digital Dentistry integration and increasing Senior Lecturer posts. Discussion also centered on hematology and biopsy handling, stressing that all patients should report to the Oral Pathology department for these investigations. This will ensure that cases are directly seen, better documented in written form, and given more clinical orientation.




IAOMP SPECIAL CASE

NODAL METASTATIC OSCC WITH INCIDENTAL NODAL METASTATIC PAPILLARY THYROID CARCINOMA

A 48-year-old female patient presented with pain, swelling and an ulceroproliferative growth of 3x2 cm on the edentulous region of 45,46,47 (FIG 1). OPG reveals resorption of alveolar ridge (FIG 2) with a provisional diagnosis of Carcinoma of right mandibular alveolus. Biopsy specimen was histopathologically reported as poorly differentiated OSCC. The lesion was surgically excised along with mandibular resection and right-side neck node dissection upto LEVEL V was submitted. Histopathologically Level IA, IB, III revealed tumour(OSCC) metastasis (FIG 3) reported along with ENE in level IB. Level III nodes (size: 1.8 cm × 1.2 cm) histopathologically showed loss of capsule and revealed proliferating cells in a papillary arrangement with nuclei showing marginal chromatin and a clear center (resembling Orphan Annie-eye nuclei) (FIGs 4&5). Also revealed areas with cells (with similar nuclear features - Orphan Annie-eye nuclei) lining a central area containing dark eosinophilic colloidal material, closely resembling thyroid follicles. The other cortical and paracortical regions of the lymph node showed lymphoid follicles, large blood vessels, adipocytes, hemorrhagic areas, and tumor cell (OSCC) invasion.

FINAL DIAGNOSIS:

- 1.POORLY DIFFERENTIATED ORAL SQUAMOUS CELL CARCINOMA WITH NODAL METASTASIS.
- 2.METASTATIC PAPILLARY THYROID CARCINOMA (INCIDENTAL FINDING)








